Golf in Iceland







DAY 1:

Scheduled arrival at Keflavík International Airport. Pick up your rental car, category N (Skoda Octavia). Drive to Flúdir for five nights at Icelandair Hotel Flúdir. Located in south Iceland, just an hour's drive from the capital Reykjavík, Hotel Flúdir offers quality, three-star accommodation in a modern, one-story building.



A drive into the interior brings you to the world-famous Geysir geothermal area followed by Gullfoss, the queen of Icelandic waterfalls. Obtional, Golf at Geysir.



Play golf at Flúdir in the morning. Flúdir golf course might be defined as a forest course. The golf course is located in the middle of south Iceland near the village Flúdir, only 100 kilometers from the capital, Reykjavík. The course is situated on farm called Efra-Sel and is surrounded by trees, which are placed along the fairways and the areas in between. The river Litla Laxá plays a key role on some of the fairways. The course is relatively easy to walk. The Icelandic name for the golf course is "Selsvollur". Enjoy the local swiming pool before your dinner at the hotel restaurant or at the course clubhouse.



Visit the Westman Islands, a small volcanic series of islands off the south coast. Drive to Landeyjarhöfn on the south coast for a 40 min ferry to the islands. Play a round of golf in the Westman Islands and make it back to Hotel Flúdir by afternoon. The Westman Islands golf course is located on one of the larger islands off the south coast of Iceland. The golf course, which is set in an old volcano, is a wonderful test for all golfers.

DAY 5:

Drive to Thingvellir, one of Iceland's national parks. Thingvellir is one of the most frequently visited tourist sites in Iceland. Each year thousands of visitors come to become better acquainted with Iceland's greatest historical site and jewel of nature. Visitors can get up close with the nation's history and nature of Thingvellir as well as access to hiking trails throughout the park. Not far from Thingvellir is Nesjavellir, Iceland's largest geothermal power plant. Nesjavellir geothermal plant generates electricity and hot water by utilizing geothermal water and steam. The plant's output is 120 MWe and 300 MWt/1800 liters per second.

DAY 6:

Return to Reykjavík to stay for the last night at the Nordica Hilton Hotel. In the afternoon you have a tee time booked at the Reykjavík Golf Club. The Grafarholt golf course is the oldest 18-hole golf course in Iceland. The course is recognized as Iceland's premier championship venue and has hosted many European and Nordic tournaments. After golfing you can relax at the hotel spa.

DAY 7:

Depart from Keflavik International Airport. Return of rental car at airport.
